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How to walk in God's infinite and unending supply

My God Shall Supply

But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

PHILIPPIANS 4:19

The Apostle Paul here makes a striking statement to the New Creation. God has undertaken to meet man's every need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

This means that the believer cannot fail since God is his guarantor. In business, you are only as strong as your capital allows you to be, or as strong as your financier. This statement by Paul to the saints at Philippi gives the believer access to the bank of Heaven. Failure has become a thing of the past.

Need is the human condition. You come into this earth needing. Very soon after birth, a baby needs its mother's milk. And it goes on needing nourishment the rest of its life! Man needs air to breathe every few seconds. To live is to need.

God is well aware of this. The Father knows you need things. Need itself is not evil; God made us dependent on Him. However, need is evil when it is not supplied. That condition is called lack or poverty. Often, this leads to debt. These are satanic conditions. They are the result of sin; not just an individual's sin but the presence of sin in the created order. Sin means to fall short. It is a shortfall, a falling short of God's glory and perfection.

Such shortfall was never God's will for man. Man was created in the image and glory of God. Although religious people hate it, man was actually created to be perfect. Religion likes to keep

man as a cur and a wretch but the grace of God will always seek to restore man to his exalted position as a king. The fall of Lucifer tragically led to the fall of man in the garden of Eden and so man became tainted with Lucifer's shortcomings.

This meant that man's need became too great. It weighed him down. The more he strived to make up the shortfall, the more in debt he became. Poverty, lack and debt became man's normality. As man abounded in transgressions and iniquities, he became chronically and hopelessly a debtor. Human beings could not pay the debt they owed to a perfect, holy God.

However, Jesus came and wiped man's debt away. His blood is the ransom price for every child of Adam. This meant that supply could flow unhindered from God to man. Even under the Old Covenant, God had endeavoured to meet man's need. When Israel walked in obedience to YHWH under the Old Covenant, they knew peace and plenty; however, when they backslid, lack and poverty quickly flooded their circumstances.

The Israelites were the descendants of Abraham through Isaac and Jacob. Abraham was the man God chose to covenant with to get His supply flowing in the earth. God promised to bless Abraham so that he and his descendants would eventually bless every nation and family on earth. Biblically, to bless means to empower someone to prosper and succeed with every resource at your disposal. It means to refuse to allow someone to fail. It is like Bill Gates setting you up in business with millions in capital, then sending customers in to patronise you, while paying you a £1million-per-week salary AND paying all your bills. In short, it is a deal where you cannot fail.

This covenant with Abraham comprises the Old Covenant made at Sinai with the children of Israel and the New Covenant made in the body and blood of Jesus Christ. The New Covenant contains all the blessings of the Old and incorporates the Abrahamic Blessing itself, which the Apostle Paul sums up in Romans 4:13 as God making Abraham the heir of the world. In short, the believer owns the world. This planet is meant to produce superabundant wealth for the descendants of Abraham.

Christ is Abraham's Seed (Galatians 3:16) and so is the Christian (Galatians 3:29). Therefore the supply of God belongs to us.

Lack is a thing of the past for the believer. You should not even remotely countenance lack in your life. God shall supply ALL your need, child of God! Whatever you need to fulfil your God-appointed role in life is yours for the taking. Not for the asking, mind you. If you want to be polite, go ahead and ask. But rude children get the same supper as polite ones. Supply is the children's bread, be it healing, prosperity, deliverance... whatever your need is.

Jesus Christ came to obliterate need in man. That is, the cloying satanic need of lack. He came with Good News for the poor, those who had no resources. There is only one kind of Good News to a poor man: poverty days are over! A lot of people like to wax lyrical about the Gospel. But you only really know the Gospel if you have known biting lack in your life – lack of health, peace, finances etc.

The Gospel of Jesus Christ is a statement of release for the poor. It is God's promise to swamp the poor with supply! He does this by giving the power to get wealth. This comes in two

parts. Firstly, there is the *dunamis* to get wealth. *Dunamis* means dynamic miracle power. It is a supernatural power. The believer can expect God's very own power to flow in his life to bring wealth and riches. Then there is the *exousia* power. This means the authority or Divine Mandate to get wealth. It means you are entitled to the wealth because of your rightstanding with God. Jesus referred to this in Matthew 6:33.

But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

MATTHEW 6:33

All sorts of religious ideas have been put forward about this verse. Religious thinking interprets it as saying we should put God and the work of God first, particularly in our financial giving. Lots of people have gone broke flogging that old mule. That's not what Jesus is saying. He is telling us here that in order to have our needs met we need to be dominion-minded. We need to see that God rules. After all, that is the Gospel (Compare Romans 10:15 where Paul speaks about the Gospel with the original Old Testament passage in Isaiah 52:7 and you will see that the Gospel is that *our God reigns*). And this Gospel is Good News to the poor because it says that the God who loves the poor and wants to swamp them with supply is in control. If you want to come out of poverty and fretting about what you are going to eat and wear, you need to get that way minded about it.

And you need to see you have a right to supply. That's what seeking His righteousness means. Righteousness means the ability to be in God's Presence without fear or condemnation. And nobody goes into the Presence and comes away empty-handed. Anyone who says otherwise is a liar.

This is why Paul says God will meet your need according to His riches in glory. Your supply is in the glory realm! When you go into His Presence, you go into the glory and you don't come away empty-handed! When the glory was present back in wilderness days, there was manna in the morning and quail in the evening (see Psalm 105:39,40). The Presence brought provision. Provision comes from the glory.

The believer has a right to supply. You are not supplied because you give to ministries; we need to do away with such baby ideas. You are supplied because you have a Divine right to supply! Jesus brings this out in Matthew 6:26. "Look at the birds," He said. The birds weren't engaging in the sowing and reaping frenzy of the televangelists... "Yet your Heavenly Father feeds them."

Jesus then makes a statement that blows away the "You have to give before you get" crowd. He says "Are you not much better than they?" If birds don't have to give to televangelists to be blessed, why should you and I? Aren't we more important than the fowls of the air, brothers and sisters?

As you read on in Matthew 6 you see that Jesus then highlights that your right to supply isn't even based on whether you work or not but is based on your preciousness to the Father. Of course, we have to temper this with Paul's statement in 2 Thessalonians 3:10 that if a man will not work, neither should he eat but Paul was referring to people mooching meals off the church without helping out.

The essence of what Jesus is saying in Matthew 6 is that God has undertaken to meet man's need and that the key to seeing this manifest is simple faith and a realization that God gives us

the authority and the right to have our needs supplied. This is far better than the toiling and spinning of the rat race or the legalistic sowing and reaping espoused by cash-hungry ministries. Recognising that you have a right to supply and that supply is yours is God's system.

This is just the same in finances as it is in salvation, healing, deliverance etc. In short, you cannot earn or buy the blessing; you can but receive it by simple faith. The supply of God in material things does not come by "giving till it hurts" just as justification does not come by doing good deeds. Both are gifts obtained by faith. Supply is your right, just as salvation is. It is not something you could have earned but is a grace, a favour from God. He is the One who has qualified you to receive.

I have a right to expect God to supply me. This drives religious people crazy because, for all the talk of some of unmerited grace, they will deny a man's right to it. Yet God's granting of grace is His declaration of right to it. This is what righteousness means. Even champions of free grace like to whip a man who says he has a right to expect God to bless him.

Religiosity is a curse to humanity. It has many nefarious disguises, even hiding behind spiritual-sounding teaching. And it has one over-riding purpose: to prevent man from walking in the consciousness of God's superabundant supply. From religious people who tell you that such talk of supply is money-loving to crafty preachers who tell you that you must give (to them) before you can receive, there are many snares that would prevent you from walking under an open heaven. Of course, you must be on guard against the deceitfulness of riches and giving to ministries is a good thing. But your right to supply is not affected because some are deceived nor is it based upon your giving but upon the blood of Jesus Christ.

Your right is not about what you do or have done but is imputed and imparted to you by the Lord. This is why you can be bold and declare your righteousness i.e. your right to receive. Understand this: satan will contest in every way he can your ability to walk in manifested supply.

...there is no want to them that fear him.

PSALM 34:9

There simply is no lack to those who fear YHWH. Understand that only fear-thinking, which is religion, would attempt to put any qualifications on this. Take it for what it says, child of God. There is NO LACK to those who fear Jehovah!!

The beauty of it is this: if you wish to live a lifestyle of superabundantly lavish supply, with no lack at all, all you have to do is fear the Lord. This doesn't mean cowering in terror before God; it means to reverence Him and esteem Him very highly.

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:

2 CORINTHIANS 9:8

Note that having all sufficiency in all things comes as a result of the *grace* of God. It is not based on performance; it is a grace and favour issue. Being so wealthy that you have all sufficiency in all things, so that you give out of your overflow, is a result of FAVOUR abounding toward us. It is the favour of God that brings the supply. You get rich by FAVOUR, not by works.

For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.
2 CORINTHIANS 8:9

We get rich because Jesus became poor for us. He died so that we may have eternal life. He took our sins so that we may be the righteousness of God in Him. He bore our shame so that we may be brought into glory. He became a curse for us, that we might be blessed. He took upon Him our sicknesses, that we may be healed. It is the Divine Exchange. We are made rich because He became utterly poor at the cross. This does not infer that Jesus was a poor man while on earth. See my book *Jesus: Millionaire* for further information.

The supply of God that exists in the glory is ours *by right*. We do not have to beg for it. No earthly father would countenance his children begging for their supper. Whatever is on the table belongs to the children! A sane child would run into the house and say "Where's mine?" It is twisted fear thinking that has the child of God beg the Father for what has freely been given already. We are not mendicants approaching a distant lord; we are children of the King! If it's in the glory, I want to tell you, it belongs to me! You can stay outside with the servants and beggars or you can run into the house and get your stuff; it's up to you.

Supply comes to the believer as his right in the earth. The amount of supply is up to you; it is not determined by God. How much do you need? Take that and many times more. You can give the surplus away to others. This is the heart of God in the matter. Just don't be greedy, looking to hoard based on fear or try to build you a little empire of your own. That kind of thinking will get you run through with a lot of pain and hurt. It's a *YHWH*

& *SONS* enterprise we are engaged in. You don't get to buy out the Management and run your own private business.

You can be as rich as you want to be if you will be light about it all. If you keep in mind that the supply is great but the Supplier is infinitely more desirable and glorious, you'll be ok. Keep your eyes on the Giver and you can enjoy the gifts with a suitably detached heart/ Never give your heart to the stuff but give it only to YHWH.

Why take more than you need? Because somebody has to help those who don't know how to take their portion. Also, it's better, in the mind of God, that the power of wealth be in the hands of *His* people rather than the devil's bunch. A lot of people don't credit God with that much good sense.

**Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the
heavenlies in Christ
EPHESIANS 1:3 VW**

Supply is our right. It is not something we have to beg for. This verse in Ephesians shows us something absolutely vital to manifesting supply: that what we seek has already been supplied to us. The things you seek to manifest exist already in heavenly places. This means that there is a spiritual equivalent in the glory realm to what you seek in the physical universe. You need those things to show up in this sub-light-speed dimension. They will do so because they already exist in a supra-light-speed dimension. They exist in the spirit realm.

Faith is the process of grabbing hold of those things that exist in an invisible, above-the-speed-of-light reality and bringing them into this dimension where they can be seen. The key thing

to understand is that what you seek already exists!! Supply is already yours. Manifestation is simply believing or “faith-ing” those things into visibility. Manifested supply is simply something taking form or shape in this physical universe which is an equivalent of what exists and has been provided already in the spirit realm. This is what it means when it says your need will be supplied according to the riches that are in glory.

In the glory realm you have abundance. Everything you could possibly ever need or desire has been provided. The word “provided” comes from “provision” which means that which has been previously seen. Something you have “faithed” into manifestation here in this physical dimension already exists in glory and can be seen with the eyes of faith. The formula is very simple: if you can see – by faith – what you desire in the glory, you can have it manifest here on earth.

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

JOHN 1:1

Here we get to the very essence of manifesting supply. The system God has set up is that all things begin with the Word. In the beginning is the Word. All things begin with a word. Speech is what makes man like God. All things were made by the Person of the Word, the Son of God, we are told in verse 3 of John chapter 1. Hebrews 11:3 informs us that the universe was framed with the Word of God. Man, like God, forms his universe by his word.

In Ephesians 1:3 we read that every spiritual blessing exists for us in heavenly realms in Christ. We could say it this way: every spiritual blessing exists for us in heavenly places in the Word, since Christ is the Word. Therefore, all the blessings we

wish to have exist in the Word. If you can find it in God's Word, it has been pre-provided for you!

To see these blessings come into this physical realm, you must begin with a word. You must speak the blessings into manifestation. **SUPPLY COMES BY SPEAKING IT INTO MANIFESTATION.** You must speak the thing you desire into manifestation. Of course, it must be a thing you can find in the Word. There is no point speaking into manifestation that you are the best thief in the world or something else that goes against the Word. You cannot say you are married to another man's wife and expect there to be any substance from God's Word to such a statement. It is fine to desire a wife – you can find a lot of Scripture to speak concerning that. Just don't make it someone who is already married!

Don't desire and try to speak into manifestation something that is not lawful. On that note, if you are speaking for a spouse, don't try to manipulate people by choosing someone and then trying to talk God into brow-beating that person to marry you. Let God bring the right person. Your job is to speak the right person into your life. You can and will be supplied with the right marriage partner if you look in the Word for that person and not around the church. Let God be your Source.

Likewise, don't speak that someone you know with lots of money will give you some, or other manipulative stuff like that. Such things are an abuse and a misuse of faith. Speak that money comes to you but allow God to be the One who takes care of the details. He is your Source, not the millionaire you know. Any preacher will tell you that often the millionaires they know are the poorest contributors.

It is God who supplies. Let Him be God and you just be blessed!

With these necessary qualifications in mind, just remember that, as Jesus said in Mark 11:23, you can have what you say. If you will SAY what God has SAID in His Word, then whatever God said will be yours. The vital thing to remember is that you are not saying to get a blessing, you are saying because you are already blessed. True faith is possessing, not trying to obtain. Jesus taught this principle:

Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

MARK 11:24

Some translations have this in the past tense i.e.. “believe that ye *have* received them.” A.T. Robertson, in his Word Pictures In The New Testament, notes how the Greek tense can mean that the receiving spoken of is antecedent in time to the believing. This means that we are believing for something which already exists and which we have already received. Of course, this is what Paul said in 1 Corinthians:

Therefore let no one boast in men. For all things are yours: whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas, or the world or life or death, or things present or things to come; all are yours. And you are Christ's, and Christ is God's.

1 CORINTHIANS 3:21-23 VW

All things belong to us. Operating in faith is simply the process by which we bring into manifestation that which has been provided in glory already.

He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

ROMANS 8:32 VW

God has freely given us ALL THINGS. 1 Corinthians 2:13 tells us that we SPEAK THESE THINGS (see 1 COR. 2:12,13). Speaking the pre-existent supply of God is the essential factor in manifestation. Believing that we are already supplied and speaking that supply into manifestation is our duty and privilege.

Your job is to put God's Word regarding supply into your mouth and never quit speaking it. My own breakthrough came one day when I spoke Philippians 4:19 over and over for a few hours. That night the Lord woke me up and said these words to me:-

***“BE NOT NEED CONSCIOUS BUT BE GOD
CONSCIOUS. BE GOD SHALL SUPPLY
CONSCIOUS”***

Right then the Lord began downloading revelation knowledge concerning heavenly supply into my spirit and it hasn't stopped flowing all these years later! You see, supply comes from what you speak about what you know. And by "know" I am not talking about mental knowledge of data or facts. I am talking about mysteries – things hidden *for* us, not *from* us – that you can only receive by the Holy Spirit.

To walk in supply you are going to have to understand that your supply is in the glory realm and that you need to access that realm to get it. Doing this practically involves speaking the

Word on supply over and over until that Word begins to take root in your spirit and talks to you!

Take a verse like Philippians 4:13 or 2 Corinthians 8:9 and meditate it extensively. Speak confessions and affirmations based on the verse. Also, if you are baptised in the Spirit, use your heavenly prayer language far more. This means you will be speaking the will of God - which is supply – and also mysteries. Which is the Bible way of describing supply! Remember that God gives exceeding abundantly above all you can ask or even think!

Let me illustrate this. One day the Lord impressed upon me very strongly to speak that someone was going to give me a certain amount of money. I did this and within a very short space of time – it might even have been the same day from memory – a man gave me three times this amount. Now the amount I spoke was what God revealed. The three times this was the mystery part!

I remember asking the Lord why this man gave me three times what He had told me to speak and His answer was: “Are you complaining?” My answer was an overwhelming no!

You see, the mysteries are very often the happy surprises – the exceeding abundantly over and more. This is because God pours out supply with a very big pitcher. And He is not so precise in His measures! By that I mean He would rather give you way more than just enough . And less than enough is not part of the deal.

This is why the Psalmist says “My cup runneth over.” There is always superabounding supply at the Lord’s table.

It is vital to understand that you must have revelation of all of this. You cannot walk in this by head knowledge. Faith is seeing what is yours in invisible realms. You need revelation to see the things that belong to you i.e. the infinite, never-ending supply that is in glory. Faith is the heavenly materiality that comes into your spirit and forces the physical realm to manifest the supply you desire. Faith is thus the bridge between things that exist in heavenly dimensions and their manifested equivalent here on earth.

I like to think of faith as the transporter beam (Trekkies will get this) bringing things from the unseen world into this one. This includes salvation, healing, deliverance, provision, angelic protection, favour, guidance etc etc.

The biggest mistake you can make is to look to this lower dimension for your supply. Yes, things can be “magnetised” to you here on earth. This is where the Law of Attraction stuff comes from. But your SOURCE is YHWH-YIREH and your supply is in the realm of glory. Some things you believe for can only come from there such as the new birth, healings, miracles etc.

Other things will be from a more earth-based location e.g. if you are believing God for a new car, you are not going to get one from the heavenly automotive line! But because God has chariots up there and because you will have unlimited travel access in your celestial body, you can believe God for a nice, luxurious – and fast – equivalent down here.

Equally, you can believe God for a beautiful home because He has prepared an awesome one for you up in glory land.

The supply of God will be either direct from heavenly realms or a suitable earthly equivalent to something that is in heaven. You must see God and the glory dimensions as the Source of your provision.

The word “provision” is a compound of two words – “pro” meaning before and “vision” meaning something seen. When you see the things you desire in glory, this *provision* will be *provided* for you!!

How do you see this invisible supply? Friend, that is what your Bible is for. That is why you have been given the Holy Spirit. So that you can see and speak the things that are yours by covenant right and so that you can walk in unlimited blessing and favour.

God’s supply is infinite and inexhaustible. It is also sure. The speed at which it manifests here on earth is the variable and can be attributed to certain things. Some things, for example, are seasonal. If you are believing God for a baby they normally take 9 months from conception!

It is vital to take this on board and understand that God wants to supply us at the faith level we are at. A great example is believing God for a jet plane to take you all over the world to preach. This is something you are not really ready for if you are presently functioning as a youth pastor in your local community! Also, jet planes take both high levels of revenue and certain logistical requirements to maintain.

It’s not a good testimony to believe God for something you are not able to sustain at your present level. Supply must be something that enhances your life, not something that disturbs it in such a way that you fret or lose your peace. There is no point

in having billionaire-level faith in finances if you cannot cope with the emotional and mental pressures such wealth might bring.

Supply is a faith matter and your faith must be developed and rounded. Falling down in this is often the reason men and women lose the blessing that is on their lives. Believing God for supply is one thing. Walking in the faith level required to maintain the supply and not let what was once a blessing become a curse is a whole other game.

We see this in people who become dependent on miracles and live their lives bouncing from one miracle to the next. Wealth is not about miracles as events so much as it is about walking in constant and consistent miraculous blessing. It is great to have a testimony of God delivering you by a financial miracle but you are supposed to develop your faith in the blessing so that He doesn't have to. You are supposed to be someone else's miracle because you are as YHWH is in this world.

You see, God makes people rich so that poor folks can see who He is in His people. Your walking in infinite, superabounding supply and the billionaire blessing of Abraham is God's advertising to a needy world. That is why manifesting supply is not just optional to the life in Christ; it is mandatory. You **MUST** manifest supply because you **MUST** manifest the Kingdom.

The wise person will not, therefore, just believe God to supply wealth but also to supply everything that is required to live a wealthy life and **BE** a wealthy person. Walking in God's supply is not just about having stuff or manifesting stuff – it is about being the person you are called to be.

The king or queen in you must be supplied, funded and resourced at appropriate levels. This is the way of it. Royal sons and daughters are funded as such. They live in palaces, dress luxuriously and are attended by servants.

Remember when Jesus was born He was funded at a very young age by the visiting aristocrats from Parthia. The train that attended these Magi was so vast that it scared the living daylight out of Jerusalem, whose inhabitants feared it was an invading force.

Jesus didn't get a wee dab of myrrh and frankincense, with a trinket from a cheap gold boutique. He was funded to the level of a king! The Parthians believed Jesus was the bona fide successor to the Arsacid dynasty. Parthia was a mighty superpower at the time and was feared by the Roman Empire. Jesus was born in the middle of a lengthy truce between Rome and Parthia. Parthians were, according to historian Steven Collins, descended from the scattered Northern Kingdom of Israel.

Jesus the poor Man is a religious myth. As the Seed of Abraham, Jesus was entitled to walk in Abraham's Billionaire Blessing. So are YOU!! You are entitled as a joint-heir with Christ to receive God's infinite supply. Jesus was funded and resourced based on who He was, not what He did for a living.

God's people will begin to walk in superabounding supply on this earth when we begin to realise that we are not supplied based on what we do or earn but on who we are because of what He has done for us.

On the cross of Calvary, Jesus burst open the windows of heaven and made infinite supply the right and privilege of every

believer. Of course, you can be a chump and refuse this but you are dishonouring Him if you do.

If you are in Christ then you are in the place of unlimited, inexhaustible supply. You cannot be in lack or go short when you know who you are and what belongs to you. The supply of God is yours. The riches and treasures of God belong to you. Heaven's plenty is available to drown any need you have on earth in oceans of supply.

This supply includes money, property, precious stones, mineral wealth, jewellery, stocks and shares, clothes, cars, businesses, land and anything else you could need.

God is your Supplier and the Infinite Source of all supply to you. Receive this truth and let it transform your mind and life.

All supply is based on consciousness. This is because all manifestation is based on consciousness.

You manifest what you are conscious of. More precisely, you manifest what you are conscious of having in invisible form.

This is why the so-called Prosperity Gospel fails miserably to work for people. It begins with the premise that you don't have! It tells you that to have, you must give.

HOW CAN YOU MANIFEST (MAKE VISIBLE) IF YOU DO NOT HAVE IT IN THE INVISIBLE?

Or put it this way: If you have nothing in the invisible, what will you then manifest?

This is why my inbox has heartbreaking stories from people all over the world - tithers and givers - who have been burned by this give-to-get-rich message. You don't get rich by your giving, friend. You get rich by the New Covenant in Christ's body and blood.

Manifestation means to make visible in this realm something that you see with the eye of faith in the invisible realm of glory. You have to see that you have the supply in the riches of glory!

When Jesus said "Give and you shall receive" He was simply saying that the universe works in your favour! It will multiply whatever you give right back at you because of the law of reciprocity and the law of multiplication. These laws are inbuilt and will work for anybody who uses them – like farmers and businessmen,

Of course you can get rich that way but no follower of Christ has any business trying to get by works what God gives by grace. And supply is a grace matter, not a works matter.

You don't get rich by your giving. You get rich by faith then you get richer by using the laws of sowing and reaping. That is the right way, This is why in the stewardship parables of the minahs and talents the stewards always started off with big sums of money.

Get rich, then give is God's way. The other way is fool's gold. **YOU CANNOT MANIFEST WHAT YOU DO NOT BELIEVE IS YOURS.**

All supply comes from faith. You must believe you have received in the invisible to have it manifest in the physical world.

In the New Covenant, supply is yours. You cannot give to get God to open the windows of heaven. He already opened them!


