

# **ABRAHAM THE BILLIONAIRE**

The first thing you must understand about developing billionaire consciousness is that you ARE a billionaire.

You are a billionaire because someone else was made a billionaire and the blessing he was blessed with is one you share and inherit.

Your billionaire status comes from the Abrahamic Covenant.

Abraham was God's covenant partner, the man God chose to covenant with in the earth.

We see the beginnings of this covenant in Genesis chapter 12:-

Now YHWH had said to Abram:

“Get out of your country,

From your family

And from your father's house,

To a land that I will show you.

I will make you a great nation;

I will bless you

And make your name great;

And you shall be a blessing.

I will bless those who bless you,

And I will curse him who curses you;

And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

**GENESIS 12:1-3 NKJV**

YHWH's promise to Abraham was that He would bless him and make his name great. In other words, He promised Abraham that He would make Him rich and famous.

To be blessed in the biblical sense means that someone – in this case Almighty God – will use all of their resources and their status to empower the blessed one to succeed.

God was thus covenanting with Abraham that He would be his partner and empower him to be successful and renowned. YHWH Himself stood back of His own promise to Abraham.

At this stage Abraham was called Abram; later on YHWH inserted His own Name into Abram's, changing it to Abra-h-am.

A short while after this, Abram returned from a trip to Egypt laden with riches and wealth that were given to him by Pharaoh.

So God entered into covenant with Abram and a short time later the man is funded at an extravagant level by the ruler of the world's then superpower!

**Here is the lesson: When you are in covenant with Almighty God, expect the rich people of this world to fund your dream.**

Yes, I know you don't hear that preached much but you will if you come to my meetings!

When Abram came back from this little journey to Egypt, the Bible says he was VERY rich in cattle, silver and gold (Genesis 13:2).

Interestingly, these just happen to be the commodities of God Himself. Psalm 50:10 records that the cattle on a thousand hills are YHWH's and Haggai 2:8 informs us that the gold and silver belong to Him.

When you partner with the Almighty, He makes sure you have some of His commodities.

In Abram's case, he had so much that between him and his nephew Lot, the land could not hold them!

When God blesses you, the number one problem you have is finding storage space to contain the blessings.

Another lesson to be learned here is Lot. He wasn't what we would call very spiritual and he wasn't God's covenant partner

but he had sense enough to latch onto the man who was. And as a result, he got blessed too.

Why did God allow that? After all, some might say that Lot sponged off of Abraham's blessing. Here's why:- Abraham's blessing wasn't just for himself. The Abrahamic Blessing is to bless every family on earth (Genesis 12:3).

Abram was blessed to be a blessing (Genesis 12:2). This means that people blessed with this Abrahamic Blessing are meant to channel this Blessing, not just receive it.

There is no doubt that the blessing upon Abraham's life made him so rich he was what we would call today in the billionaire class. On one occasion there was a local war that Abraham got involved in. He had his own private army and used it to rescue his nephew Lot who had been taken captive.

Only billionaires have their own private armies. It is clear from the account of this in Genesis chapter 14 that Abraham was considered to be a very high-ranking person and moved in royal circles.

The blessing of God on your life will cause you to become the confederate of society's highest ranking people.

# **BLESSED WITH ABRAHAM'S BLESSING**

You might be thinking: "If only I could get a deal like that with God, I could be blessed like Abraham."

Well, the truth is that you don't have to get God to make such a deal with you; He already has!

You don't need your own deal with God and He isn't looking for another partner. The reality is that He has made provision for YOU to walk in the same covenant and blessing as Abraham!

Abraham is the man God chose to make covenant with so He could get His Son born into the earth and reverse the curse brought upon humankind by Adam's fall. Jesus, God's Son, was born into a family descended from Abraham.

Jesus lived a sinless life and died on the cross for our sins. Three days later He rose from the dead. You will likely have heard this and be familiar with the concept that Jesus died for our sins.

What you might not be so familiar with – even if you are a Christian – is that Jesus died for another purpose. That purpose is to get Abraham's Billionaire Blessing on you!

**Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.**

**GALATIANS 3:13,4 NKJV**

Notice that the blessing of Abraham comes on the nations *in Christ Jesus*. Those who are Christ's are Abraham's seed since He is the seed of Abraham (see Galatians 3:16,29; Hebrews 2:16).

If you are a Christian, you are Abraham's seed and an heir of the promise i.e. the Abrahamic Covenant and Blessing.

This means that the Billionaire Blessing of Abraham belongs to every Christian!

How sad that some believers refuse to walk in this blessing because they don't want to be corrupted by money. You don't have to love money and you are a sorry excuse for a Christian if you allow fear of loving money to crowd you out of the Blessing of Abraham.

Deuteronomy 8:18 shows us that the power to obtain wealth is an inherent part of the Abrahamic Covenant:-

**And you shall remember YHWH your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.  
DEUTERONOMY 8:18 NKJV**

The covenant with the fathers referred to here is the covenant made with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob i.e. the Abrahamic Covenant.

The power to get wealth comes to establish or ratify this covenant i.e. to back it up and prove it. This power is supernatural – it is the power of God.

Don't let anybody try to talk you out of this blessing by saying it is an Old Covenant blessing and not applicable or available to us today.

The Word of God plainly states otherwise.

It is not an Old Covenant promise; it is a blessing of the covenant made with the fathers i.e. Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

This Abrahamic Covenant predates the Old Covenant, which was made with Israel at Mount Sinai. The Abrahamic Covenant actually overarches the Old and New Covenants; these are component parts of the Abrahamic Covenant.

So the power to get wealth is a blessing that is part of both the Old and New Covenants! That is why the Bible says it is effective at this day.

Galatians chapter 3 explains this further by saying that the giving of the Law i.e. the terms of the Old Covenant came 430 years after the Abrahamic Covenant and cannot annul or render ineffective the promise of Blessing it contained (see Galatians 3:15-18).

Jesus died on the cross so that this Blessing could be in our lives without any requirement to keep the Law.

The “promise of the Spirit” mentioned in Galatians 3:14 is a reference to the reality that God Himself would come and live within us to empower us to prosper and get wealth.

In other words, the One who blessed us would come live in us to make the Blessing a reality!

This happens through faith, not law-keeping.

Abraham’s Billionaire Blessing is so massive and comprehensive that, according to Romans 4:13, it makes Abraham the inheritor of the whole planet!

**For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.  
ROMANS 4:3 KJV**

Note that Abraham’s right to this wonderful destiny also applies to his seed as much as to himself.

Also, please note that the Blessing was Abraham’s right to walk in BY FAITH.

Paul specifically states that the promise was not through the law.
